Monthly highlights

- Electrical usage in July 2026 was down 1% compared to June 2025. Nine schools had a reduction in energy usage. Eight schools had an increase in energy use.
- Multiple schools had significant reductions in July:

Dixie Heights	-22%	R.C. Hinsdale	-18%
Ryland Heights	-18%	White's Tower	-15%
- High outside air temperature/humidity continued to impact energy usage in schools with unit ventilators due to increased HVAC run times.

River Ridge	63%	Beechgrove	15%
Woodland	27%

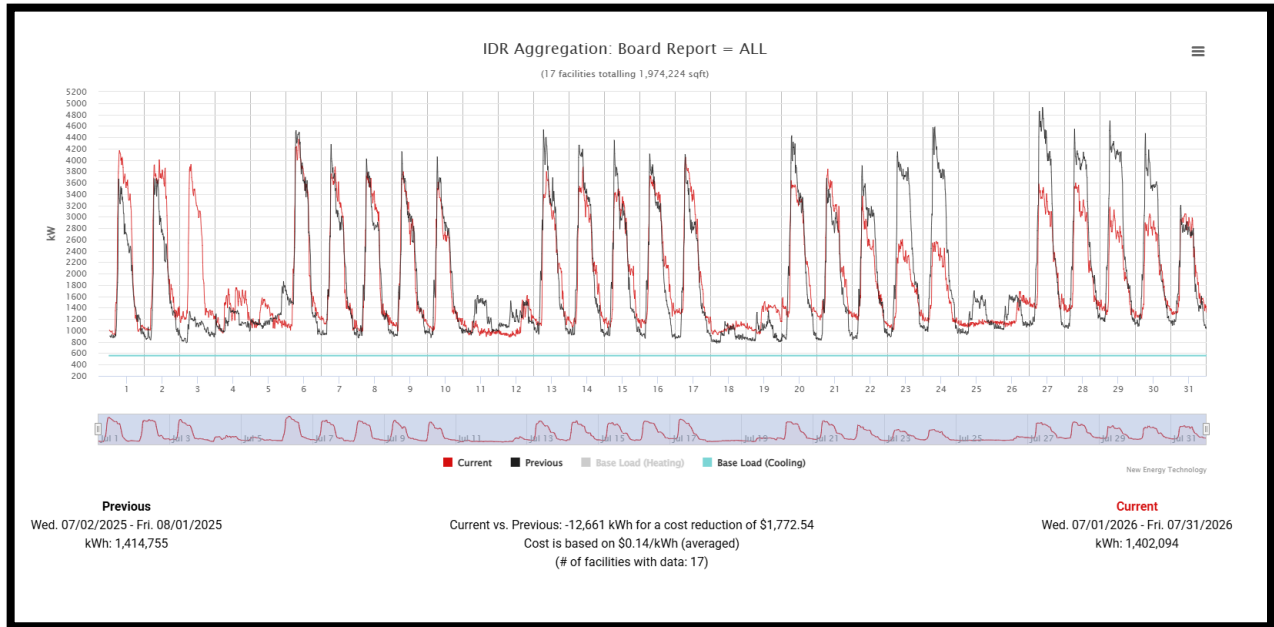
Facility ENERGY STAR Scores (Board Report = ALL) - Jun 2026



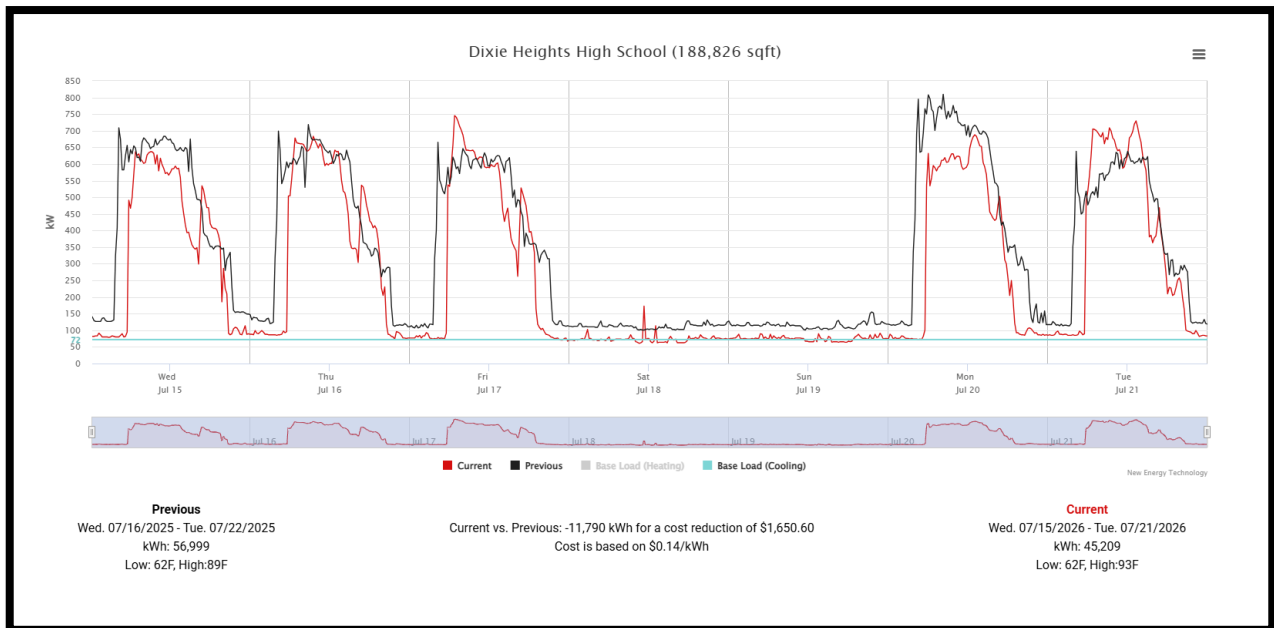
15-minute Interval Data

Electricity Load Profiles

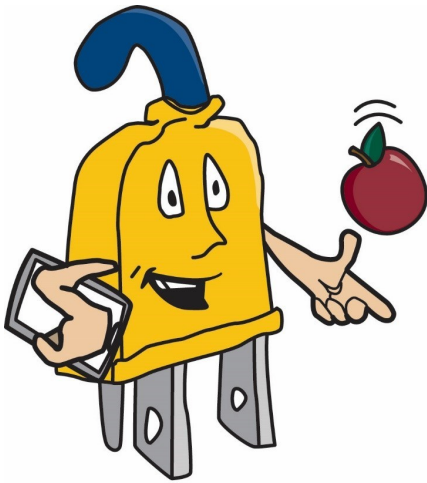
Data in this section is directly from utility meters and updated daily.



Electrical usage in July 2026 was down 1% compared to July 2025. Nine schools had a reduction in energy usage. The largest reduction was Dixie H.S. (22%.) Eight schools had an increase in usage with the largest increase realized at River Ridge Elementary (63%.) This was due to increased HVAC run times in an attempt to moderate indoor humidity levels.



Dixie Heights High School realized a reduction in energy of 22% or approximately \$7,692 in the month of July. Even with higher outdoor temperatures, Dixie Heights was able to reduce energy consumption by controlling occupied schedules and reducing overnight usage.
